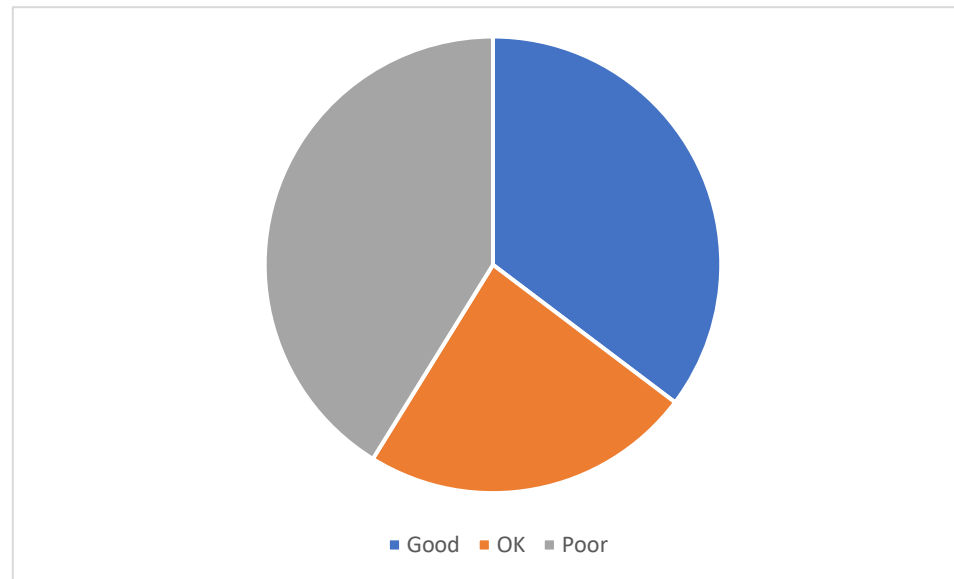


Review – Aftersun
